This versatile approach allows for deep study or meditation, perfect for individuals, families, or small groups. All are invited to join a discussion group meeting in the Fireside Room at 9 AM each Sunday, starting January 12, through March 30. Invite the Holy Spirit to lead you!

Here are a few suggestions for engaging in the text:

- Begin and end the day meditating on some or all the week's verses.
- Read from a different translation of the Bible each weekday. (i.e. Monday=NIV, Tuesday=NLT, Wednesday=NASB, etc.) Choose a different form of engagement each weekday. (i.e. Monday=Read aloud, Tuesday=write it out, Wednesday=Pray it, etc.)
- Sit quietly before the LORD after reading, and wait upon Him to respond to you in a personal way.
- Ask God questions. Especially if conviction or emotions are brought up. "Jesus, what do you have to say to this?" Sit with Him awhile and talk it through. Step into repentance and forgiveness and begin to renew your mind with His revealed Truth.
- Go deeper with the cross references and other study notes available in your Bible.
- Look up the Greek definitions and what Bible commentators have to say.

Lean in, linger, listen, and have fun!
